## Our Annual Shearing is Saturday, April 6! Come See Our Alpacas Bare All!

Every year in early Spring, we bring a shearing crew to the farm to shear our herd and harvest the year's fiber crop. The 2019 Shearing, which is a one-day event, is set for Saturday, April 6!

Shearing Day is an exciting and fun-filled day during which we run Shearing Tours to the farm so individuals can see firsthand how shearing is done and learn about our alpacas and their fiber.

In addition to our one-hour Shearing Tours that were so popular last year, this year we have added two, three-hour Shearing Tour/Tractor-Pulled Hayrides to the tour schedule for those individuals who would like to spend additional time touring the farm and visiting with the other animals after seeing the shearing.

Seats on our Shearing Tours and Shearing Tour/Tractor-Pulled Hayrides are going fast! If you are interested in reserving a seat on these tours, please call 757.707.5052.

The one-hour Shearing Tours are \$10/person, age 5 and up. All Shearing Tours depart from the Fox Wire Farm Store & Boutique. Cash or check is preferred payment. We can accept all major credit cards; however, a \$0.50 convenience fee is applied per person to cover credit and debit card merchant fees.

Departure times for the Shearing Tours are 9:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m., 2:00 p.m., 2:30 p.m., and 3:00 p.m. Reservations are not required, but strongly recommended!

The three-hour Shearing Tour/Tractor-Pulled Hayride is \$35/person, age 5 and up. This very special tour has limited seating for 15 people per tour to provide an expanded and fun-filled opportunity for viewing the shearing and then experiencing a more comprehensive tour of the farm and our animals, including lots of one-on-one interaction. These tours depart promptly from the designated parking area on the farm at 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Reservations and pre-payment are required prior to the day of the tour for those signing up for the Shearing Tour/Tractor-Pulled Hayride. Participants will be given a gate pass/ID badge so they can drive onto the farm to park and meet up with their tour guide at the reserved time in the designated parking area.
